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SELF-SELECT CLASS 2018

The Year 7 Self-Select class, commencing in 2018 at Ingleburn High School, will provide motivated and enthusiastic students the opportunity to develop deeper knowledge and understanding across all curriculum areas through innovative teaching practices and learning strategies. Self-Select is an excellent opportunity for students who wish to take ownership of, and increase engagement in their own learning and who want to work cooperatively with like-minded learners who are dedicated and driven.

Students will actively engage in a variety of tasks designed to enrich and challenge them in a positive and supportive environment. Teachers will provide a learning environment which meets the unique learning needs of the class. The class atmosphere will encourage students to work to the best of their ability, equipping them with the skills to become modern day learners.

Students must submit the following information for their portfolio and answer the questions on pages 2, 3 and 4. Students will be required to submit a portfolio of no more than 3 items which demonstrate their capacity for independent and motivated learning; this could include, but is not limited to, certificates, letters of recommendation, photographs of artworks or musical achievements. Students are to complete applications individually without the assistance of their parents.

Self-Select applications will be reviewed by a panel of staff from Ingleburn High School who will assess each individual student's suitability for a placement in the program.

Applications are due Friday 13th October 2017 and need to be lodged at the front office no later than 3pm. Students who successfully gain a place in the program will be notified in writing no later than Friday 15th December 2017.

As part of this application process, the panel will also consider whether individual students may be accelerated beyond their year group in specific subjects. If this occurs, the parents will be contacted for an interview with the Principal to discuss the next steps.
